A New Era of Rehabilitation Psychiatry

Dear Fellows, Members, Inceptors and Affiliates,

We are very pleased to announce that the Clinical Division of Rehabilitation and Social Psychiatry of the Hong Kong College of Psychiatrists has reached its' 9th months' operation. Since its establishment in Sept 2009, 28 fellows, including representatives of rehabilitation teams from all seven HA clusters, have joined our clinical division. **Dr Roger Ng** was elected as the chairperson and **Dr Joey Leung** as the secretary.

The Clinical Division serves to make recommendations to the college on the core competencies and training standards for trainees. It will support and facilitate inter-disciplinary learning between psychiatrists working in psychiatric rehabilitation and mental health professionals working with the community partners.



Moreover, it will provide an advisory role to the college and other relevant bodies in the service development of rehabilitation psychiatry in HK.

It will encourage and facilitate research activities conducted across various centers so as to promote evidence-based practice of rehabilitation psychiatry.

In addition, it will support and collaborate with community partners in the education of service users, caregivers, and the general public on various issues conducive to the promotion of recovery from mental illness and integration into society as a whole.

The clinical division will publish a newsletter half-yearly to report the progress of the clinical division and to keep fellows informed of the current activities and plans of the division.

Our coming AGM cum Symposium on 9 Oct 2010
