Each winner will be given approximately HK\$20,000 for the purpose of financing a period of overseas training in psychiatry of his/her choice before July 2007 or to attend the Annual Meeting of the Royal College of Psychiatrists of that year.

The prize for the best presentation in the New Fellows Forum of the Annual Scientific Meeting 2006 was awarded to **Dr. LEE Yiu Ki** for his presentation entitled "*The ability to recognise facial emotion in children with attention deficit hyperactivity disorder in Hong Kong*".

#### **IV. The International Association for the Improvement of Mental Health Programmes: Course on Leadership and Professional Skills**

**The International Association for the Improvement of Mental Health Programmes** invites the College to nominate suitable candidates for fellowships to attend a special *COURSE ON LEADERSHIP AND PROFESSIONAL SKILLS* to take place in Hong Kong from *24 to 28 June 2007*.

Candidates can be those who:

- (1) are psychiatrists close to the completion of their postgraduate training or psychiatrists within five years of the completion of their training;
- (2) are proficient in English;
- (3) have a recommendation by the head of their institution or the facility in which they are to complete their training;
- (4) do not plan to leave their country for at least two years after the completion of this training course.

#### **STRUCTURE AND CONTENTS OF THE LEADERSHIP COURSE FOR YOUNG PSYCHIATRISTS**

The main features of this course are its emphasis on practical issues, opportunities to interact with teachers (and with other participants), active participation in training activities and the provision of specific advice about problems that the participants may bring forward.

The course will last six half-days. The programme includes topics such as “How to prepare a poster”, “How to review a paper”, “How to teach clinical skills”, “How to write a scientific paper”, “How to give a lecture”, “How to chair a meeting”, “How to select a topic for research”, “How to do research with little or no resources”, “How to participate in a multi-centric research”, “How to plan services and evaluate them”, “How to assess needs for mental health care. A part of the programme is left flexible so that it can be adapted to the specific needs of the participants.

The faculty of the course will be composed of three teachers in addition to the Educational Director of the programme who also participates in the teaching. The teachers participate in the course throughout and, as a rule, spend their free time with the participants.

In advance of the course all participants will receive a description of the programme and an indication of what is expected from them during the course and as a preparation for it.

The organiser of the course is the Association for the Improvement of Mental Health Programmes (AIMHP). This non-governmental, non-profit organisation is located in Geneva, Switzerland. It collaborates with the World Health Organisation and other nongovernmental organisations in the performance of its tasks. Support for this course has been received through an unrestricted educational grant from the Eli Lilly Foundation, Indianapolis, USA.

Applications are called for from interested members of the College and fellows with less than five years of post-fellowship experience. Applications should include:

1. A full curriculum vitae
2. A recommendation by the head of your working institution
3. A photocopy of the passport page indicating the age of the applicant
4. A one-page summary detailing the reasons supporting your nomination by the College
