Research Mentorship Programme for Trainees in the first 18 months of training- Pilot Program 2016-17

The main initiative of this research mentorship program is to cultivate research interests and basic research skills through a time-limited and highly selective mentorship program for keen researchers in psychiatry.

Program details

Mentors are leaders of research teams based in the following research and training centers:

- i) Department of Psychiatry, The University of Hong Kong;
- ii) Department of Psychiatry, The Chinese University of Hong Kong;
- iii) Department of Psychiatry, Kowloon Hospital;
- iv) Castle Peak Hospital

Trainees eligible for the program:

- 1) junior trainees within first 18 months of training at the time of application;
- 2) having keen interests in exploring psychiatric research topics and methods;
- 3) preferably having prior exposure to mental health research

Mentoring process:

- 1) time-limited, 12 months
- 2) regular individual meetings between mentee and mentor
- 3) participation in regular research meetings of mentor's research team (NB.: NO protected time will be given if the meeting is held during office hours)
- 4) At the discretion of the mentor-mentee collaboration, mentee may conduct a short-term research protocol under mentor's guidance.
