Dear Fellows, Members, Inceptors and Affiliates,

I. College Emblem Design Contest

Background

The emblem of the College was designed by a senior Fellow Dr. Winston Chiu. The idea was based on the Chinese Taoist literature of “莊周蝴蝶夢”. To better represent the current development and achievements of our College in the past years, a new design for the College emblem may seem timely.

In the spirit of involving all our college stakeholders in this important work, the College Council would like to call for a competition and invite all interested College Fellows, Members and Inceptors to participate and submit designs for a new College emblem.

Procedures of entry into the competition

The contestant should submit in a sealed envelope the emblem designs (drawn by hand or computer) in full colour on an A4 sheet of paper (only one emblem design per sheet) accompanied by a brief description (no more than 150 words) of the idea behind the design on a separate sheet of paper, together with another sealed envelope containing the name, correspondence address, and telephone number of the contestant, a reduced copy of the submitted emblem design as well as a declaration by the contestant stating that “This is my own work. I authorize the selection committee to publish or display the design both during and after the competition. If my design is selected, I authorize its use as the emblem of the Hong Kong College of Psychiatrists without restrictions of time or form, and without claims for royalties or other remuneration, apart from the rewards that are contained within this announcement”.

Each contestant is allowed to submit more than one design in which the submissions have to be made separately.

The College has the rights to publish, show or use all the submitted designs in any public display. The College will not accept responsibility or liability for any legal action arising from the submission of plagiarized materials, or otherwise arising from the conduct of the competition.

Deadline of submission

The submission must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. on 31st July 2013.

Submission may be delivered in person from 9:00am until 5:30pm, or by posted mail, in a plain envelope to the College Secretariat as follows:

Applications sent electronically will not be accepted.

Process of selection and announcement of the results

A selection committee which is formed by all the previous and present Presidents of the College together with Dr Winston Chiu will vet all the submissions to decide on the best design. The best winner of the contest will be awarded a souvenir. His/Her idea behind the new design and the College acknowledgement of his/her contribution in marking the milestone of the College will be put into the College website for reference.

All the submissions will be vetted by the committee and the results will be endorsed at the Council meeting. The results will be announced in the College Newsletter and the winner will be notified individually by letter.

The College Council reserves the rights to decide whether to adopt the winning design, with or without modifications, into the new emblem of the College. The new College emblem will be announced in the College AGM 2013 and be adopted in 2014.

There will be an inauguration of the new College Emblem in the WPA Regional Congress 2014.

External Examiner of the mid-year Part II Fellowship Examination

Professor Ian P Overall from Australia will be the external examiner for the coming mid-year Part II Fellowship Examination in May. He has been at the forefront of research into cellular, molecular and genetic changes in the brain in major psychiatric disorders for over twenty years. He is currently the Cato Chair and Head of Department of Psychiatry, University of Melbourne.
