#### II. **Proposed Subspecialties Establishment in Psychiatry**

A ballot on the resolution of proposed subspecialties establishment in Psychiatry was conducted at the 25<sup>th</sup> AGM held on 12 December 2014. A scrutinizer for the ballot counting by a certified public accountant was recruited and the result of the ballot counts is as follow:

Valid ballot papers counted	177
Invalid papers counted	0

Total ballot papers printed	352

The result of the 177 valid ballot papers is as follow:

- voted for the resolution	44

With 44 votes for the resolution and 132 votes against the resolution, the resolution on proposed subspecialties establishment in Psychiatry was not adopted at the 25<sup>th</sup> AGM.
